Heather Asbury launches Dallas interior-design company

Dallas has its share of talented females with interior-design firms under their belts – Jan Showers, Emily Summers, Laura Lee Clark. And now on their stylish heels: Heather Asbury.

The self-taught designer, who moved here in 1989 to attend Southern Methodist University, just launched Asbury Interiors. The interior-design and project-management company's services include construction consultation, sourcing furnishings and designing custom furniture, lighting, bedding and rugs.

She does everything from working with the general contractor to ordering fabrics for the drapes.

"I have clients that hire me to handle a move-in down to making sure their favorite toothbrush is in the drawer ready to go," she says. "But sometimes I'll have a client that just needs a powder bath done. I only take one or two clients at a time to really deliver customer service."

Asbury has no formal interiors degree, but has a decade of design experience, including working as an associate buyer for Neiman Marcus and as general manager at Beretta Gallery in Highland Park Village. Her past projects include an upscale-rustic Colorado lodge, Hollywood glam residence at the Ritz-Carlton Dallas and five lodges for T. Boone Pickens' ranch.
